Kemp Lake is approximately 1 hour **west of St. Louis** off Highway 44. The lake is 19 acres and is nestled in a **215-acre property** that has over 6+ miles in trails.

Kemp Lake has plenty to offer for everyone!

**Fishing:** Fish from floating "breakaway" docks that make getting on and off the water easy for just about anyone. In summer, two connected docks are often taken out - one with **shade** and one without - this can add a wonderful comfort factor. Bass, bluegill and crappie are abundant on the managed lake.

**Hunting:** Hunts for turkey, deer and rabbit. There have been several upland bird hunts, too. There are two **accessible and heated hunting blinds** available. A motorized wheelchair is also available if needed.



**Pavilion:** We are excited to announce that we are completing construction of an all-new lakeside pavilion! It holds **80+ participants**, family and

others and features 3 bathrooms (2 wheelchair-accessible), a PA system and plenty of picnic tables.



**& More!:** Explore our trails in **golf carts** or go **birdwatching** with our resident expert. The possibilities are endless!
